

ENGAGEMENT PORTRAIT INFORMATION

1. The first stage is to select a day to shot the portraits. It takes on average 5 weeks to provide a finished print. For framing, add another couple of weeks. In emergency situations, our quickest turnaround could be 3 weeks. It's a bit rushed but doable. I recommend 8 weeks prior to wedding day to be safe. We encourage weekday photo shoots. Saturdays are reserved for weddings and Sundays are personal days, but exclusions may apply.
2. Once the date has been selected think of location. San Antonio and surrounding areas have so many "photo friendly" locations. Take advantage of these opportunities and choose a location that matches your personality and style. If you choose a location outside of San Antonio, travel fees may apply.

Tip: Google these locations for photo samples and visit their websites to determine which one feels best for you. Also find out about their schedules, availability, fees (if any) and schedule of activities to avoid crowds.

3. Next time of day. Best times for outdoor photography is early in the morning or late in the afternoon. For example, if sunset is at 8pm, we would recommend starting at 6pm. The only exclusion would be if it's a cloudy day since light conditions are the same for most of the day.
4. A day or two before the set date, we'll contact you to confirm weather and location to meet. If bad weather is expected that day, you'll have to decide if you want to cancel or do a "last call" an hour prior to the set time to postpone the shoot.
5. A photo session takes 90 minutes. If we have two locations close by, we can add an extra 30 minutes for free. Each additional 30 minutes is \$75. Thirty minutes late or a no-show will incur a \$75 re-scheduling fee.
6. For clothing options think of weather and location. Be comfortable and use your choice of elegant or casual. The best colors to use are vibrant colors like red, green or blue. Try to avoid light colors and black.
7. Some couples like to send photo ideas prior to the session. We welcome your input. Please email images to info@infinityweddings.com. It is recommended to limit this number to no more than 15 images.
8. This is our regular turnaround: Two weeks after the session, we'll email you to provide you the web gallery information to view the images. Once you view them, provide us a list of your favorite 10 in an email. Each image has a file number, use that for reference. We will edit these images to make them look even better than the originals. If you have any specific requests please let us know. It takes two weeks for us to finish your edits. We will send you another email to let you know the edits are ready to view on the same web gallery. You will be able to download from here as well. The next step is to provide us the one image you will want to enlarge. The package comes with a 16x20 and for an additional \$20 we can print a 16x24. These enlargements come with backboard. The printing process takes a week. We will email you once again to pick up the print and the disc with all the images.
9. We do not frame. We recommend Michael's, Hobby Lobby or any other professional Frame Shop. It is not necessary to add glass to the frame. Easels are usually provided by the reception venue, but to be safe check with them.
10. Last, when you pick up the print, you will also pick up a disc with all the images. These images are full resolution and do not have any watermarks. You get to keep these images as well. You can also print these images and showcase them at the wedding. You have printable rights so feel free to print as many as you need or ask us to print them for you.

Tip: Feel free to bring a second outfit to change, if time allows we can use it. Also, bring water a small makeup kit and cash for location fees. Last, during humid and hot days the guys need to be aware of perspiration over dark colors. This will save the photo editor a lot of time in Photoshop ;)
